Buddhism adheres to the basic Indian view, one shared with Hinduism and Jainism, that human existence is part of an ongoing cycle of multiple lifetimes (samsara) the circumstances of which are governed by one's deeds or actions (karma).

Rather, Buddhism is the very lifeblood of the community, and its influence is seen in all aspects of daily life. The Tibetan language does not even have a term with the same connotations as the English word religion. The closest is the word *chos* (chos), which is a Tibetan translation of the Sanskrit word *dharma*.

Dharma, the Dharma consists of the teachings of the Buddha, and thereby of Buddhism. That certain things are really, really, true is central to Buddhism. Buddhists claim that it is really true, for example, that most things form part of a causal flow, and physical matter is not in any sense one's true Self (atman).
